Members - The next Men's Club MAJOR Tournament is the **Member/Member - Member/Guest** on **Tuesday 21 April** - North Course. .

This is a two man team event where the Team Score is the best NET score from the team. On the entry form you will see blanks that must be filled in.

Any two Regular members, regardless of their Handicap indexes can join to make up a team. A member can also join with a non-member Guest. The Guest does not have to have a GHIN Handicap number. His handicap will be determined by the USGA "Golf Genius Tournament Program" after he plays and then the USGA program will give him a course handicap for that day and compare it to the hole by hole score of his partner (the Men's Club member) and their Best Net Score on each hole will be calculated by the program. It does that very very quickly.

Each two man team is competing against all other two man teams for what will be the BIGGEST Prize Purse of all !!!!

An IMPORTANT NOTE:

You will notice that the entry form asks each person to indicate what tees he (or she, as ladies may be guests) will ,play from...White; Combo (White/Gold), or Gold. When choosing the tees to play from please follow the following Men's Club Rules on which tees to play:

1. IF a player's Handicap Index (not his course handicap) is 7.9 or less, he cannot play from the GOLD tees. He MAY play from the White or Combo Tees. Note his Tournament Handicap will be adjusted according by the World Handicap System for what tees he plays from. For example a 7.9 playing from the Combo Tees gives up 3 Handicap Strokes...just so you know.
2. Any player, male or female, can play from any 18 set of tees they want for the tournament. Obviously a "20.0 Handicapper" who plays from the White or Combo tees is going to SLOW UP play considerably so be aware of that, because there will be Marshalls who may ask a player to "Pick up" rather than slow down play for everybody behind them.

After the round there will be a full buffet lunch and the awarding of the huge Prize purse.....Team Score, SKINS, CTFs.
