

Admiral Baker Men's Club
Monthly Board of Governors Meeting
Mar 3, 2026

- Meeting called to order by Club President John Bepko at 12:24 PM. All governors were present.
- **Minutes** of Feb 2026 meeting accepted.
- **Treasurer:** Mark Manlove said we have about \$35,000 in the bank, and should have about \$39,000 at the end of the year based on projected expenses and income.
- **Blitz:** Bobby Skinner said the 6/6/6 format used today needs to be changed as Golf Genius cannot calculate results for that format We will use Progressive instead.

-- He said John Donnelly, who has experience with Golf Genius from Torrey Pines Men's Club, will be assisting in our blitz management He will manage an upcoming blitz, with Bobby overseeing this. Once John is comfortable doing this, both of them will take turns. John Bepko stated Bobby is still Blitz Director until further notice, and John Donnelly will go through Bobby for all major items for now.

- **Rules:** Don Longacre said SCGA may be willing to conduct a training session here if enough people are interested in attending. John Bepko said he would like all Board members to go through the rules seminar if possible, and he will try to get SCGA to do it here.

-- Don reminded all that rakes should be left **outside** bunkers and **parallel to** fairways.

-- Pat Weishan raised the issue of hazard marking on North holes 13 and 15. John Bepko said we should paint tops of the fence posts on 13, and he will discuss this with Austin Daniells.

Drop Zones on South Course: Nothing new on this since last meeting. John Bepko said he will check to see if course managers have drop zone signs we could use on holes 3, 9 and 13.

- **SCMGL:** John Bepko said the league has significant rules changes this season. For example, team best ball net will be used instead of individual match play. This is being done to speed pace of play. Pat Weishan reported we have 27 men signed up now, so openings exist for others to join our team.

Membership: Ed Rosenbloom reported we have 872 regulars, 407 associates for a total of 1279.

Match Play Tournament: John Bepko said a notice is going out this week for signups. It is \$50 to enter.

New Business: John Bepko addressed the following issues:

-- General Membership Meeting/Tournament: 98 people currently signed up. 128 is the limit. A premium lunch is set with ABMC paying \$26.95 per person for that. John has plenty of tee prizes to give out to players.

-- Comps: Governors get \$73 SCGA fee comped. Other comps are major tournament entry fees to Bernie Hoyt and Steve Koudelka for all the work they do setting these up, and blitz entry fees to the Blitz Director for his work each week. This will go to either Bobby Skinner or John Donnelly, depending on who managed that week's tournament.
