

The 2026 Admiral Baker Club Championship  
will be on **Tuesday 28 July** and **Weds 29 July**

1. Courses. 28 July South Course; 29 July North Course
2. Eligibility. All Regular Members who have played in at least two Men's Club events in the past 12 months.
3. Competitions.
  - a. **Club Champion.** The player with the lowest total GROSS score played from the WHITE TEES.
  - b. **Senior Club Champion.** The player who is 55+ on 28 July with the lowest total GROSS score played from the WHITE TEES.
  - c. **Super Senior Club Champion.** The player who is 70+ on 28 July with the lowest total GROSS score played from the WHITE TEES.
  - d. **ULTRA SENIOR NET CHAMPION.** The player who is 80+ on 28 July with the lowest total NET score played from either TEES.
  - e. **WHITE TEE NET AWARDS (1<sup>st</sup> FLIGHT).** The players with the lowest total NET score played from the WHITE TEES.
  - f. **GOLD TEE NET AWARDS (2<sup>nd</sup> FLIGHT).** The players with the lowest total NET score played from the GOLD TEES.  
**NOTE:** The number of places paid in the NET competition will be determined by the number of entrants in each FLIGHT.
  - g. **Closest to the Flagstick.** The player from any tee who is closest to the flagstick on each Part Three hole.
  - h. **SKINS.** The player(s) from any tee whose GROSS score on any hole is the lowest GROSS score on that/those hole(s).
4. FLIGHT ASSIGNMENT. FLIGHT ( tee box) assignments will be based on the tees that each player has previously designated as his "Default Tees" in Golf Genius for Men's Club tournaments. White TEES ( 1<sup>st</sup> Flight) will be for players who have chosen the WHITE TEES or the COMBO TEES as their Default tees. GOLD TEES (2<sup>nd</sup> Flight) will be for players who have chosen the GOLD TEES. Entrants who have not established a "DEFAULT TEE" will be assigned a Flight based on their Handicap Index as of 21 July. White Tees is the default tee while players over a Index of 20.0 will be assigned to the GOLD TEES.
5. RULES. USGA Rules of Golf for STROKE PLAY will apply, as modified by Men's Club Local Rules which will be distributed in the "Conditions of the Competition" to all players prior to the tournament. A player who encounters a situation on the course where he is unsure of the correct USGA Rule MUST comply with USGA

RULE 3.3 (“Stroke Play”) and RULE 20 (“Resolving Rules Issues During the Round”) Please review the USGA Rules on “Playing two balls” and how to “Notify the Committee” (Rule 20.1c). The Admiral Baker Rules Committee will resolve all issues and their decision is final.

6. PRIZE PURSE.

1. Each Low GROSS Club Champion wins \$300 cash.
2. The Ultra Senior Net Champion wins \$100 cash **in addition to** any Gross or Net prize he also wins.
3. WHITE TEE NET awards the 1<sup>st</sup> Flight players who did not win any of the three Low Gross awards. The amount and number of places depends on the number of entrants.
4. GOLD TEE NET awards the 2<sup>nd</sup> Flight players. The amount and number of places depends on the number of players.
5. Closest to the Flagstick awards \$50 in Pro Shop Gift cards for each Part Three. These Gift Cards can be used for ANY expense in the Admiral Baker Pro Shop such as Green Fees, Range Balls, or Material.
6. SKINS prize purse divides \$300 for each day’s Skins to the winners.

7. AWARDS and LUNCH. There is a full buffet Lunch for all participants where the prizes will be given out. Any winner who is not present to personally collect his award may designate someone to pick up his prize envelope, but that notification must be done to a member of the Tournament Committee BEFORE the winner leaves the course; otherwise his award will be withheld for future distribution. Any award given to a substitute will be considered already awarded to the winner. Each winner or substitute will sign for his award when he receives it.

8. The Club Championship is one of the Men’s Club’s biggest tournaments; hence the Prize Purse is “Enhanced” to a larger total than a usual tournament. The newest “Category” of Champions, the **Ultra Senior Net Champion** is started this year to recognize and honor the “Most seasoned” of our Regular Members for their longevity and loyalty to Admiral Baker Men’s Club.

9. Players may indicate on their entry forms that they would like to play with another member(s) by name. Write down the name(s) in the space below your GHIN and we will try to grant each request. However, each request may be granted only after both players have paid their entry fee.
