

Admiral Baker Men's Club
Monthly Board of Governors Meeting

June 2, 2026

- Meeting called to order by Club President John Bepko at 12:20 PM. All governors were present except Fermin Ancho.
- **Minutes** of the May 2026 meeting were accepted as written.
- **Treasurer:** Mark Manlove said we have about \$28,000 in the bank, with another \$3,000 in the mail for a total of \$31,000. So, we are in good shape.
- **Membership:** Ed Rosenbloom said we have 877 regular members, 401 associates for total of 1278.
- **South Course Drop Zones:** Don Longacre said we can start using the drop zones next week. Bobby Skinner will advise all members of this. Holes 3, 9 and 13 will have the zones painted on the grass and Men's Club signs, which John Bepko procured, will be up. NOTE: Don Longacre advised once you hit a provisional ball on these holes, you may no longer use the drop zone.
- **Club Championship:** John Bepko said Club Championship, Senior Championship and Super Senior Championships will all be played from the white tees. Entry fee for all will be \$150.
- **Blitz:** Bobby Skinner suggested we change our policy that says if a player is guilty of 3 late cancelations or no shows in a month he can't play the next week, because this rarely happens. The Board agreed and Bobby said out new **blitz policy** will be: players will be disciplined as necessary for late no shows/cancellations.
- **Match Play:** Ed Rosenbloom reported the tournament is moving well, but players need to pay better attention to where they put their names on the chart to ensure correct placement.
- **SCMGL:** Pat Weishan sent notices to all player scheduled for the Camp Pendleton match. Also, he will be sending emails to all non-military players to get info he will need to get them on base at this time, since he must provide this to the camp 2 weeks before the match.
- **Rules:** Don Longacre said the Blitz Director needs to make a fix at blitz info on our club website, as there are a couple items that need deleting.
- **Handicaps:** John Thomson said nothing new going on with handicaps. John Bepko reminded all if you don't finish 18 holes just post the holes played, as long as it is at least 9. The USGA handicap system will enter scores for missing holes based on handicap indexes.
