Monthly Board of Governors Meeting Minutes

July 7, 2026

- Meeting called to order by Club President John Bepko at 12:40 PM. All governors were present.
- Minutes of the Jun 2026 meeting were accepted as written.
- **Treasurer:** Mark Manlove said we have about \$31,000 in the bank, and should end the year with about \$30,000. So, we are in good shape.
- **Membership:** Ed Rosenbloom said we have 878 regular members, 389 associates for total of 1267.
- **Match Play:** Ed Rosenbloom reported the tournament is moving along well and getting close to finishing.
- **Blitz:** Bobby Skinner said the date to change default tees has passed, and there were not a lot of changes.
- **Handicaps:** John Thomson said he received a letter questioning the net 60 a player shot on the South Course. John checked others who played with this person and the individual's latest scores and determined the score was legitimate. John also reported the USGA was into Phase 3 of their new handicap system. They want us to audit all member's handicaps. John Bepko said in view of our large membership he will check to find out details of this requirement before we move forward and report back.
- **SCMGL:** Pat Weishan said our first match is next week at Camp Pendleton, then we will play on our South course on 20 July.
- **New Business:** John Bepko covered the following issues for the Club Championship.
 - We currently have about 80 signed up for the Club Championship. Payouts will be determined after we know how many are playing.
 - The Rules Committee will come up with Conditions of Play for specific things that need addressing on both courses, e.g. bad green collars on North 7, 10, 11 and 18. Don Longacre will then present these to the Tournament Chairmen for review and action as needed.
- **Pace of Play (POP):** Pat Weishan reported recent paces have been good, and as good as under 4 hrs 40 mins for blitz completion. However, there are still issues a number of weeks with one team. Pat will contact that team with our concerns, and advise them they must play faster.
- **Relief in bunkers:** The issue of relief from footprints in bunkers was raised by a member, but the Board unanimously agreed there will be no relief for this.
