

Admiral Baker Men's Club
Monthly Board of Governors Meeting
August 4, 2026

- Meeting called to order by club president John Bepko at 12:30PM. All members were present except Fermin Ancho and Bob Bates.
- ABGC Director of Golf: Jerry Dremel attended and provided the following updates.
 - Total snack cart sales during our Club Championship were zero sales on day one and three sales on day two. Additionally, the cart operators have reported few sales on blitz days and minimal tips. Mainly players ask for free ice. This is an untenable situation for the operators, and may result in them not working ABMC events in the future. Average daily sales on days other than ABMC events are about \$300. So, our members are encouraged to support the presence and effort of these individuals.
 - DD214 rates will be coming down 1 Oct. Also, there will be a small increase for green fees effective that same date.
 - South course improvements just went out for bid again. The two main priorities for this work will be irrigation and water storage. Work on this project will probably not occur until 2029 as it works its way through the approval system.
 - Locker room renovations will take place in the November/December time frame. These will include new lockers and shower area and addition of a sink. An ABMC area will also be included. The golf shop will be redone as well, and the conference room will become a putting practice area.
 - Jerry's manning is presently down 9 people, so please be patient.
 - Our tournaments will need to be paid for NLT 5 days in advance.
 - There is a great practice facility at the 32nd St. Naval Base with the latest equipment available.
 - Filters have been added to all the water fountains on the North and South Courses.
 - Pat Weishan mentioned he had been going to the course late in the day and repairing ball marks on the first several greens on the North, but it is a time-consuming task. Jerry will try to get us some ball marker repair tools he has access to that will allow numerous marks to be fixed in a matter of minutes.
- Minutes from the July 7, 2026 meeting were accepted as written.
- Treasurer: Mark Manlove reported we have about \$27,000 in our account as of 1 August, and he estimates we will end the year with about that same amount.

- New Business: John Bepko said we will be combining the Fall Super Scramble and Fall General

Member Meeting Tournament events in late September or early October to preclude having two separate tournaments too close together.

- Blitz Skins: The new blitz skins format started today with 4 flights assembled based on handicaps, and \$100 dedicated to each flight for prizes. Payouts will need to be manually divided to other flights if one or more flights has no skins winner.

-- SCMGL: Pat Weishan said our next match is here versus Miramar, then we will play them at their location next.
